PRACTICE SAFE SUN *Melanoma Awareness*

- ☀️ **Limit your time in the sun – especially between 10 – 4**
- ☀️ **Apply sunscreen of SPF-45 or higher often, especially after swimming**
- ☀️ **Wear protective clothing, hats, sunglasses**
- ☀️ **Avoid tanning beds – their intense UV rays may cause skin cancer; try tanning sprays and lotions instead**
- ☀️ **Look for changes in moles every month** (shape, color, size)
- ☀️ **Visit your dermatologist yearly**
